After earning his Eagle, he continued his advancement by earning bronze, gold, and silver palms over the next year. As a youth, he served in several leadership positions in his troop, including Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, and Order of the Arrow Troop Representative.

Our recipient was called out into the Order of the Arrow in 2008 and completed his Ordeal the same year. He sealed his membership in the lodge, completing his Brotherhood in 2009.

In addition to being active in the lodge, our recipient attended the National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) and has served on staff for the course. Congratulations to the 2015 youth and 122nd recipient of the Thunderbird Award, the Immediate Past Lodge Chief, Evan Bair!


Martin Barbie
