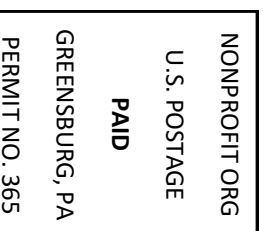
## Wagion Lodge #6 August 2016
