

## WAGION LODGE 6 100 ANNIVERSARY AWARD GUIDEBOOK

## Overview:

Arrowmen seeking to earn the Wagion Lodge 6 100 Anniversary Award must adhere to the following Guidebook. Arrowmen must earn a certain number of activity points in order to qualify for an Award. Activity points are distributed between four sections, with each section divided into Bronze, Silver, and Gold achievement levels. Success depends both on overall activity points earned, as well as obtaining high achievement in a minimum number of sections.

Arrowmen may begin working on the 100 Anniversary Award requirements after January 1, 2018. Without exception, award applications must be received, along with any fee for the purchase of Award item(s), before 11:59pm on December 31, 2021.

## Requirements:

Maintain registration and membership in good standing in the Boy Scouts of America and Wagion Lodge 6 AND

Earn 50 activity points to qualify for the Bronze Anniversary Award

Earn 100 activity points, AND achieve Gold in one of four sections to qualify for the **Silver Anniversary Award** Earn 140 activity points, AND achieve Gold in three of four sections to qualify for the **Gold Anniversary Award**

## FAQ:

Q: May my Financial Support activity be combined with an employer match to meet my contribution level? A: Yes. Please ensure, however, your employer permits a charitable match to the Westmoreland Fayette Council. Some charitable matches are limited when made in fulfillment of a pledge or for the return of some other gain.

Q: What does an "X" in the activity's Bronze column mean?

A: There is no ability to earn points at the activity's Bronze level. You must achieve the Silver or Gold level to earn points in this activity.

Q: I am not currently registered as a "Boy Scout," but rather as a [Venturer/Sea Scout/Explorer/Lone Scout]. How can I qualify for the Personal Development requirements?

A: Leadership Positions, corresponding awards, and training programs will be recognized for meeting these requirements. (Summit Award (Youth Venturer); Quartermaster (Youth Sea Scout) Explorer Award (Youth Explorer))

Q: I am currently a youth but will turn 21 years old on or before December 31, 2021. What requirements do I use?

A: For purposes of earning the Wagion Lodge 6 100 Anniversary Award, "Youth" is defined as any Wagion Arrowman who was under 21 years of age on any date between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2021. "Adult" is defined as any Wagion Arrowman was over 21 years of age prior to January 1, 2018.
