#### **FINAL DAY TO REGISTER -AUGUST 1; ORDEAL CANDIDATE REGISTRATION EXTENDED -AUGUST 6**

Still haven't registered for the Wagon 100 Anniversary Weekend this August 12-15 at Camp Conestoga?? Today – Sunday August 1 – is the final day to sign-up to join the celebration! Don't forget, anyone can attend using the DAY PASS option. Day Pass registration is \$25 per person and includes lunch and dinner, commemorative patch, and access to all guest activities. Day Pass attendees may check-in beginning at 8:00am on Saturday August 14 and will depart camp following the Fireworks Spectacular (approx 10:15pm). All guests must be registered and have a name badge and pass to be on camp property during the event – no unregistered visitors permitted.

New Ordeal Candidates must register for their Ordeal Induction by calling the Westmoreland Fayette Council Service Center at 724-837-1630 before Friday August 6. Ordeal Candidate registration is \$70.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY: COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS**

The Wagon 100 Leadership Team is closely examining the latest CDC guidance, state actions, and local regulations regarding the dangerous COVID-19 virus. While mask use is not required at this time, we are monitoring the situation daily. Camp Conestoga is apart of the Pennsylvania State Park system and is subject to all applicable state mandates. The Wagon 100 Staff will make every effort to updated guests of Health and Safety concerns as the event approaches.

Guests eating inside Robinson Dining Hall will be required to dine in tables of 8, with limited space for social distancing. If you are not comfortable eating indoors with others (or simply wish for additional space of your own), Guests and Families are strongly encouraged to bring a canopy or EZ-Up/pop-up tent that may be set-up outside our dining hall.

## **WHAT TO BRING (or NOT TO BRING)!**

All Attendees (including Day Pass Attendees):

- Folding Camp/Tailgate Chair (seating is limited and social distancing will be encouraged - please bring your own lightweight chair)
- Cash or Check. (Sorry, Camp Conestoga is not equipped to accept credit/debit cards at this time. ATM machine is located about 2 miles from camp at the Coen gas station (formerly Luther's Little Store).
- Sturdy Shoes (please no sandals, flip-flops, or open-toed shoes)
- Canned Goods for Food Drive.
- Canopy or EZ-Up/pop-up tent (if desired)
- Please NO pets, golf carts, weapons, personal fireworks, or other items prohibited by Scouts BSA or the Laurel Hill State Park ([www.dcnr.pa.gov/StateParks/RulesAndRegulations](http://www.dcnr.pa.gov/StateParks/RulesAndRegulations)).

Wagon Lodge Members, including New Ordeal Candidates (check-in Thursday August 12):

- Personal tent (canvas tents not available to Wagon members). Tents should be pitched in the Hill area, using the Catawba, Shawnee, and Paiute sites, as well as the large grassy areas between the Hill Pavilion and Paiute or between Blackhawk and the Hill Shower House. Ordeal Candidates must use the Shawnee site. Do not use canvas tents: these are reserved for out-of-council delegates.
- Appropriate gear, uniforms, sash, other items directed by Lodge or Induction packet
- BSA Health form (Parts A&B)
- Please limit vehicles in camp. Wagon members must park in the lower lot near the camp entrance or in other designated areas.

Active OA/BSA Members (Outside Host Council) (check-in Friday August 13 no earlier than 1pm):

- Canvas tents provided to all out-of-council delegates. Camp site assigned at registration. Tents equipped with metal cot (no mattress). (All bathhouses have private hot water showers and flush toilets.)
- BSA Health form (Parts A&B)
