## PROGRAM DIVISION

## Activities Committee

The Wagion Activities Committee specializes in planning and running non-service activities meant for member engagement at weekends and other events. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Creative
- Social/Engaging
- Able to lead games/fun events.


## American Indian Activities Committee

The American Indian Activities Committee specializes in various areas including ceremonies, drum, and dance. Collectively, this committee is the one which you see most often in their regalia for tap-out, Ordeal, and Brotherhood ceremonies. You may want to join this committee if you are:

## - Interested in Acting, Drumming, or Dancing.

- Interested in the possibility of Drum \& Dance competitions on multiple levels.


## Inductions Committee

The Inductions Committee houses two very important components of the lodge. On one side lies the administrative tasks of preparing the committee and/or Ordeal candidates for weekends, while on the other side lies the more engaged task of leading the Ordeal Crews as an Elangomat during weekends-having a lasting impact on the journey of those incoming members in our order. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in mentoring new members.
- Interested in helping to contact Ordeal candidates to come back to weekends.


## Cub Scouts Relations Committee

The Cub Scout Relations Committee is tasked primarily with organizing and running the annual Spring Nature Walk, typically held during May. This committee is also involved with council events oriented toward Cub Scouts from time to time. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in engaging with younger Scouts.
- Interested in planning and running events.


## Brotherhood Committee

The Brotherhood Committee is responsible for managing the process of Ordeals sealing their membership by earning Brotherhood Honor. This includes calling Ordeals prior to weekends, sending out the Brotherhood information letters to eligible members, conducting discussions at weekends with candidates, and leading the Brotherhood Walk. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in networking with fellow lodge members.
- Interested in mentoring others during their journey to Brotherhood.


## ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION

## Unit Relations Committee

The Unit Relations Committee is responsible for conducting candidate elections during the Winter \& Spring seasons. Members of this committee are most active outside of weekends, attending meetings of other units in order to conduct their OA candidate elections. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in traveling to other units in your area.
- Interested in possible networking opportunities.


## Food Service Committee

The Food Service Committee is responsible for creating menus, serving meals, and preparing the dining hall for meal-times during weekends. This committee may also work in coordination with the Ways \& Means committee in the event that evening ceremonies need to be held indoors. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in partaking in a different cheerful service project from fellow lodge members.
- $\quad$ Able to work to prepare meals and/or serve those meals to the general lodge.
- Interested in helping to maintain the dining hall and prepare it for meals, activities, ceremonies, and all else that may be hosted in it.


## First Aid Committee

The First Aid Committee is responsible for ensuring the safety of lodge members during weekends, and administering treatment for minor injuries when necessary. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in partaking in a different cheerful service project from fellow lodge members.
- Interested in ensuring the safety of fellow lodge members.
- Able and willing to provide treatment when necessary.


## Ways \& Means Committee

The Ways \& Means Committee is responsible for maintaining the OA Circle and preparing it (or the dining hall when necessary) for evening ceremonies. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in partaking in a different cheerful service project from fellow lodge members.
- Interested in working the behind-the-scenes of ceremonies and other activities in the OA circle.


## COMMUNICATIONS DIVISION

## Promotions Committee

The Promotions Committee is responsible for the management of lodge social media accounts and creation of promotional material for these accounts, the lodge website, T-Bird times, and for other committees when working in coordination with them. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Creative
- Interested in graphic design.
- Interested in engaging with fellow lodge members.
- Able to work in conjunction with fellow committee members to come up with weekend/lodge promotional materials.


## FINANCE DIVISION

## Finance Committee

The Finance Committee is responsible for running the trading post during OA weekends and coming up with merchandise ideas. This committee also manages the "Mobile Trading Post" you may have seen during the summer months. You may want to join this committee if you are:

- Interested in partaking in a different cheerful service project from fellow lodge members.
- Able to work in a customer service position.
- Interested in coming up with merchandise ideas and working with fellow committee members to make them possible.
